Staffing Providers to furnish temporary IT professionals to state agencies, universities, community colleges, local governments, and other eligible entities throughout North Carolina.

This is a multiple-award convenience contract with no stated limit on the number of awardees. Vendors admitted to the program will be eligible to compete for future staffing requisitions distributed through the MSP. Historical program spend exceeded approximately **\$169 million in FY 2023-2024** and **\$175 million in FY 2024-2025**, making this one of the largest state IT staffing vehicles in the Southeast.

The contract base period extends through **February 28, 2028**, with two one-year option periods.
